

Neighborhood/Medium-Speed Electric Vehicle Certification

Use this form to certify your electric vehicle meets the definition of a neighborhood electric vehicle (NEV) or medium-speed electric vehicle (MEV). When completed, take this form to any vehicle licensing office.

Where can I ride my NEV or MEV?

- Permitted on roads with a speed limit of up to 35 miles per hour unless banned by local law.
- Permitted to operate in San Juan County on roads with a speed limit of up to 45 miles per hour.
- Not permitted on streets and highways that are part of the state highway system.

Are there other requirements?

- Operator must have a valid driver license
- Vehicle must be registered and display license plates
- Operator must have liability insurance

Electric vehicle type (choose one):

- Neighborhood electric vehicle (NEV)** defined as:
- A self-propelled, electrically powered four-wheeled motor vehicle
 - Speed is at least 20 miles per hour and not more than 25 miles per hour, attainable within one mile
 - Conforms to federal regulations.
- Medium-speed electric vehicle (MEV)** defined as:
- A self-propelled, electrically powered four-wheeled motor vehicle
 - Equipped with a roll cage or crush-proof body design
 - Speed is at least 30 miles per hour and not more than 35 miles per hour, attainable within one mile
 - Meets or exceeds federal regulations.
