

### **Turn pop-up blocker off in Chrome (Windows 10)**


- **1. Open** Chrome on your computer.
- 2. Click More (3 vertical dots next to profile icon at the top right of the screen).




**3. Select** Settings from the dropdown menu.



4. Scroll to "Privacy and security" heading and click Site Settings.



**5. Scroll** to Content heading and **click** Pop-ups and redirects.



**6.** At the top, **click** the grayed out toggle button.




7. The setting will now say Allowed and the toggle button will turn blue.




#### **Turn pop-up blocker off in Chrome (Mac)**


1. Open a Google Chrome browser window and click the three dots at the top right corner of the screen, then **select** Settings.



2. Scroll down and click Advanced, then click on Site Settings under Privacy and Security.



- 3. Scroll down and click on Pop-ups and redirects.
- **4. Click** the toggle to allow Pop-ups and redirects.




## Turn pop-ups blocker off (Android phone or tablet)


- 1. Open the Chrome app on your Android phone or tablet.
- **2. Tap** More (3 vertical dots to the right of the url address search bar).




3. Scroll down and tap Settings.




4. Scroll down and tap Site settings.



- **5. Scroll** down to Pop-ups and redirects.
- **6.** If it doesn't say Allowed, **tap** Pop-ups and redirects.



**7. Tap** the grayed out toggle button.



8. The setting will display Allowed and the toggle button is now blue.

### Turn pop-ups blocker off (iPhone or iPad)

**1. Open** the Chrome app on your iPhone or iPad.



**2. Tap** More (3 horizontal dots at the bottom right of the screen).



**3. Tap** Settings in the menu.




## **4. Tap** Content Settings.



5. If Block Pop-ups says On, tap Block Pop-ups.



**6. Tap** the toggle button so it becomes grayed out.



**7.** The Pop-up Blocker is now turned off and pop-ups are allowed.
