

Vehicle/Vessel Bill of Sale

Use this form to gather necessary information when you sell your vehicle or vessel. **Completing this form does not transfer the title or act as a Report of Sale.** To complete the transaction, the buyer and seller have the following responsibilities:

Seller

Remove license plate from the vehicle **at time of sale**. Submit a completed Report of Sale **within 5 days** from the date of sale. The Report of Sale releases your liability from the vehicle or vessel. You can report the sale:

- In person at any vehicle licensing office (vehicles only). Fees apply.
- Online (vehicle only) at dol.wa.gov.
- Mail a <u>Vehicle Report of Sale</u> or <u>Vessel Report of Sale</u>. Include required fee in a check or money order, made payable to Department of Licensing.

Buyer

To apply for a new title, take the Certificate of Title and this Bill of Sale to any vehicle licensing office and pay all fees and taxes. You must apply **within 15 days** of acquiring the vehicle/vessel or you may pay a late fee. Late transfer fees start at \$50 and increase to a maximum of \$125.
