



Snow Bike/Tracked All-Terrain Vehicle Highway Use Declaration

Use this form to certify and register a snow bike or tracked all-terrain vehicle (tracked ATV) for highway and public roadway use. When used on public roadways, the vehicle must conform to all applicable federal and state motor vehicle safety standards. The operator of the vehicle must have a valid Washington driver license. If applying for a snow bike, a motorcycle endorsement is also required. For additional information, visit dol.wa.gov.

To register your vehicle for highway and public roadway use, you must complete this declaration when you initially register your vehicle. This allows the registered owner to maintain licenses at the same time for both motorcycle and snow bike or WATV and tracked ATV use. Take this form, a completed [Vehicle Title Application, form 420-001](#), and ownership documents to any vehicle licensing office. Applicable fees are due at time of registration.
