Use this form to certify and register a 2-, 3-, or 4-wheel homemade or assembled vehicle for highway/public roadway use. Take this completed form to your local vehicle licensing office along with the following documents:

- Certificates of ownership (title) or notarized bills of sale for the vehicles used in the assembly
- Bills of sale or invoices for all major component parts
- Receipts for all parts used in the construction
- Certificate of vehicle inspection completed by the Washington State Patrol
- Certified scale weight slip
- Declaration of Value form [TD-420-737](#)
- Odometer disclosure statement if the model year is less than 10 years old
- Frame certification (if applicable)
- Bumper certification (if applicable)
