

Blood Type Designation Request

Use this form to add your blood type to your Washington driver license (WDL) or Identification (ID) card.

This form is one of three options you can use for this process. If you have a donor card or digital record from a blood donation center, you can use one of those in place of this form.

Step 1– Prepare your request

Requester. Complete steps 1 through 3 and bring this form to a medical provider or blood donation center. Review step 5 for information on submitting this form.

Provider. Complete step 4.

Step 2– Provide your information

Step 3– Consent
