



Washington Driver License or Identification Card Change of Address

Use this form to change your address with the Department of Licensing (DOL). Changing your address with DOL is free. To learn more about updating the address on your Washington state driver license or identification card (ID), visit dol.wa.gov/addresschange. There is a fee for a new card with your updated address.

Step 1—Prepare to submit this form

To get a replacement driver license or ID:

- Bring this form to a local driver licensing office and pay a fee.
