Washington Administrative Code Notice of Permanent Rules for WAC 308-96A-560 – Special license plates.

Adoption of: WAC 308-96A-560 Special license plates – criteria for creation or continued issuance.

Effective date: These rule changes will become effective 31 days after filing or on

November 20, 2023.

What are the agency's reasons for adopting this rule?

The Department is clarifying standard specialty plate design guidelines by requiring new plate designs to show the jurisdiction at the top of the plate.

How will this change affect current specialty plate designs? Are they still in compliance with the WAC changes?	This change does not affect existing plates since they currently comply with new standards. These changes only set standards for new specialty plate designs.
