Adoption of: WAC 308-56A-525 Vehicle seller's report of sale.

Effective date: These rule changes will become effective 31 days after filing or on

February 3, 2024.

What are the agency's reasons for adopting this rule?

The Department is clarifying that authorized licensed vehicle dealers may file reports of sale on behalf of customers per SB 5282 which was passed during 2023 legislative session.
