**Washington Administrative Code
Notice of Permanent Rules for
Driver and Vehicle Records – Wheeled All-Terrain Vehicle Rules**

Adoption of: Amended: WAC 308-104-075 Driver's licenses – Prohibited practices – Suspension, cancellation, or denial period.

Effective date: These rule changes will become effective 31 days after filing or on January 28, 2021.

What are the agency's reasons for adopting this rule?

The amendment will update the Department's rules governing wheeled all-terrain vehicles. The amendment will update the applicable rules so that wheeled all-terrain vehicles no longer need to be retitled after being modified for on-road use. This rule change will ease compliance for customers and reduce administrative burden. The amended rules also feature several technical clean-ups.
