<b>Purpose:</b> DOL is removing the requirement for firearm dealers to charge a fee for semiautomatic assault rifle purchases. This change is pursuant to HB 1143, passed during the 2023 legislative session, which now allows firearms dealers to charge a background check fee for the Secure Automated Firearm E-check system run by the Washington State Patrol.
