Subject of possible rule making: DOL is considering creating a new chapter and section of rules to implement the requirements of SHB 1996 passed during the 2024 legislative session. These rules will address various topics such as licensing, auditing of company records, and regulatory oversight of recreational vehicle manufacturer and dealer licensees by the Department of Licensing.


