Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: This rule seeks to improve regulatory compliance for vehicle dealers and manufacturers by clarifying definitions related to certain vehicle dealer and manufacturer activities under Chapter 46.70 RCW Dealers and Manufacturers. The proposed amendment further defines the "soliciting" of a sale and creates a new definition for the act of "public education". Additionally, the proposed amendment adds examples of what constitutes "public education".  Reasons supporting proposal: Currently, there is ambiguity around what constitutes the "soliciting" of a sale and "public								
	education". This has created difficulties for vehicle dealers and manufacturers operating within Washington State with respect							

to compliance. These amendments will clarify what qualifies as the "soliciting" of a sale and "public education".
