- You'll need the license number of the new Designated Broker.
- The licensee's license must be in Inactive-No Active Affiliations status (i.e., not associated with a firm) UNLESS they are currently acting as a designated broker for another firm.

Replace a Designated Broker

1. Click Business Licenses link from the top menu of the Professional and Business Licensing Home page.




2. Click link in tile for business you want to replace the Designated Broker for at the Manage My Businesses page.




3. Click link for license you want to replace the Designated Broker for at the Business Licenses page.



4. Click More Actions to display all options for this license.



5. Click Replace Designated Broker.




6. The Add Designated Broker page is displayed. **Enter** the license number of the new Designated Broker and **click** the Save button.



7. Click Ok at the pop-up.



- **8. Navigate** back to the License details. The new Designated Broker will show in the Licensee Relationship section with a Relationship Status of Invited.
 - An email will be sent to the email address on file for the Designated Broker.
 - They will have **7 days** to respond to the invitation.



- **9.** After the new Designated Broker has accepted the invitation, the Relationship Status will be updated to Active.
 - The previous Designated Broker will be removed from the Licensee Relationships list.
