


# **Dealer License Plates**

This type of agreement allows for the free movement of manufacturer and dealer plates on vehicles when they are operated by the dealer (or their employee) in connection with the dealer's business (including personal use vehicles for dealer employees).

# **Farm Plates**

Farm plates are valid for use when owned and operated by a farmer and being used for transportation of the farmer's own products between the point of production and to market or warehouse.

#### **Trip Permits**

The state of Washington will honor the Oregon trip permits on vehicles purchased by residents of Washington to drive their vehicle to the nearest Washington county auditor's office to secure Washington license plates.

# Border Zone – ID/WA

There is a free travel zone between Lewiston, Idaho and Clarkston Washington which is intended to enable free entry and exit of commercial and farm vehicles into the ports of Lewiston, Clarkston, and Whitman County. Vehicles licensed in ID with goods destined for one of the ports in these locations are granted reciprocity for vehicle registration and fuel tax only if the goods are being transported directly to the ports.

# **Transporter Plates**

Effective 1/1/2022, all vehicle transporter license plates issued by Washington are only eligible for travel within Washington state. Additionally, all reciprocity agreements granting travel from other jurisdictions with transporter plates have been rescinded. No current reciprocity exists for transporter plates unless qualified on one of the other types above. RCW 46.76.065.
