Subject of possible rule making: Creation of a new WAC to address criteria for issuance of motorcycle instructional permits and endorsements, for both 2-wheel and 3-wheel motorcycles. This new WAC will address the length of validity for motorcycle permit and endorsement tests.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 46.20.510

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Currently issuance criteria are only written in DOL internal policy and are not customer facing in state law or rules. This rulemaking will codify the requirements for issuance of a 2-wheel or 3-wheel motorcycle permit or endorsement. It will also set the length of validity for each criteria.


