

Public hearing transcript for rulemaking on WAC 308-94A-005 – Certificates of title and registration

Good afternoon. This is a public hearing before the Washington State Department of Licensing being held to elicit public testimony, both oral and written, with regard to proposed rules regarding wheeled all-terrain vehicles. This hearing is being held electronically over Zoom at 2:00 PM on September 9th, 2022.
