
Step 4-Personalized plate selection

Complete this section only if you would like to personalize your plate.

Personalized plate instructions:

- Use the <u>Personalized Plate Search</u> or visit <u>dol.wa.gov</u> to see if your plate option is available. Certain letter and number combinations are not allowed.
- List plate choice in order of preference.
- Characters: You can use letters, numbers, dashes, or spaces. You cannot use unusual characters such as #, %, &, @, etc. Spaces and dashes are considered characters; leave a box empty to indicate a space.
- Clearly show the letter or number characters "I", "1", "O", or "0" (zero). Because of similarities between "I" or "1" and "O" or "0" (zero), they are treated as the same. If one version already exists, you are not able to use the other. For example, ROOT is the same as R00T and SING is the same as S1NG.
- Enter the meaning of the plate.
- Unacceptable plates include those which may be: Sexual or vulgar in nature; blasphemous; misleading; related to illegal substances; implying ethnic, lifestyle, or gender slurs; or are contrary to our mission to promote highway safety.
- Complaints may result in the cancellation of a personalized plate.
- We will make the plate exactly as indicated on the application.
- Allow at least 8 weeks to receive your plates.
- Standard-size plates have 1-7 characters; motorcycle and small trailer plates have 1-6 characters.

Step 5-Complete/Submit your application

Attach any required documents to this completed form. Include all applicable fees. For total costs, use the <u>Vehicle Licensing Office Search</u> to contact any vehicle licensing office or visit <u>dol.wa.gov</u>.

You can either mail or take this completed application to a vehicle licensing office depending on if you are requesting a personalized special design license plate:

- Special design license plate without personalization:
 - o Take this form to any vehicle licensing office and pay the required fees; or
 - Mail this form to any vehicle licensing office with the required fees in a check or money order payable to Washington State Department of Licensing.
- Personalized special design license plate:
 - Take this form to the King County Records and Licensing Services and pay the required fees; or
 - Send this form with the required fees in a check or money order payable to Washington State Department of Licensing. Mail to Application and Issuance Unit, Department of Licensing, PO Box 9909, Olympia, WA 98507-8500.

Note: Applications mailed to DOL without the required fees will be returned.

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
